 Eastward. The Diego lost sight N by N dist.
 & leaves the ship. Making them fast
 at 8 P.M. a moderate breeze from the N.E. &
 rising Northerly. Light Breeze a fresh breeze from
 N.W. to N by N. thick & raining weather. see a
 large green Porpoise. Weather, Lat. 56.54. Long 67.00

 Comm. ... with a brisk breeze from W. off Cape
 N. by E. at 3 PM the wind shifted to the S. by E.
 At 4 PM the wind to the N. by E. Mid. sea up a heavy
 fog all from S. W. split main top gallant
 sail & 1/2. Light breeze from off the
 N. At 5 PM the wind to the N. by E. passed a brig
 heading Sheering, Lat 55. 46 Long 64. 16
