 at 3 PM at 4 PM the wind to clear barometer
 Mid part light air. Lat. 20.10 N
 attempted to put 100 lbs iron from ship
 insubordinate barometer. In. 29.5. Weather
 & threatened to strike me to the heart.
 I worked the long way. Steamer. Master.
 Shooter. Lower part. com. & and got him
 to take him. set of the ship. as I consider
 him to be a dangerous man. to be on board
 I therefore fired him. his sea & got him off
