sea. increasing. at 7 P.M. bore two under close
reef main. Steer sail. M. Spence to jib. Stay sail.
at 3 P.M. a heavy sea fell on board. More & quarter
sprits & masts. Heavy spray. Spruce spruce. Calrose
Lanes washed away. Jib. coat. masts. Spruce
off. Masts. To hull. Under. Call. Sea.
Steering sails except one. Mast & main. one several
blowing in. Hurricane in. Spruce to masts
from S.W. at 9 P.M. comm. steering to the
North. carried away all. heavy sea. Spruce sail
