

1833 Ship Unear Bound to the NW coast

Blue. 2 November 30th

Commences with fine weather
employed in fitting trussel trees over head the
top of the top mast Middle & Latter Part
fine weather nothing in sight to E or S
Lat 38° 23' Long 94° 36' East

Friday December 1st

118 Commences with fine weather
and a fine breeze from NW steering SE by compass
nothing in sight at 2 P M sent down fore & main
royal mast and rigging and stowed them away for
a spell Middle Part much fog rain Latter Part
fresh breeze from NW & W steering SE
to E no observation this day

119 Saturday Dec 2nd

Commences with a strong
breeze from NW steering SE by compass
all sail Middle & Latter Part more moderate
steering SE wind shifted to W to E
Lat 40° 30' Long 102° 36' East

Sunday Dec 3rd

120 Commences with fine
weather and a fresh breeze from NW steering
E by compass nothing in sight the weather
employed in repairing the fore top sail middle
Part much the same Latter Part fine weather
wind from NW steering E by S to E no
Lat 39° 53' Long 105° 30' East

Monday Dec 4th

121 Commences with fine weather
and a fresh breeze from NW steering
E by S under all sail middle Part much
the same Latter Part light winds from
SE to E no observation in sight
Lat 39° 36'

Tuesday Dec 5th

122 Commences with fine
weather and also at 2 P M light winds
from SE sent fore top sail Middle Part
fine weather Latter Part much the same
saw two right whales without success

Wednesday Dec 6th

123 Commences with fine weather
and a strong breeze from NW steering E by S
under all sail middle Part strong breeze
Latter Part blowing a gale at 10 P M saw whales
lowered the boats the fore boat got fast and
cut from him blowing a squall so E to S
Lat 40° 00' Long 114° 00' East

Thursday Dec 7th

124 Commences with a
breeze from NW steering E by S under all
sail kept the ship off E by S under all
sail saw two right whales Latter Part fine weather
Lat 40° 12' Long 117° 30'

Friday Dec 8th

125 Commences with fine
weather steering SE wind from NW under all
sail saw several fine birds Middle Part
much the same Latter Part fine weather saw
two right whales forever without success to E to S
Lat 41° 08' Long 119° 36' East

Saturday Dec 9th

126 Commences with a strong
breeze from NW steering SE under
all sail top sails at 2 P M saw two right whales
lowered for them the fore boat got fast
and drove from him and away he went to the
windward at 6 P M took in sail Middle Part
strong breeze Latter Part much the same to E to S
Lat 40° 36' Long 123° 05' East

127 December 10th Commences with fine
weather and a fresh breeze from NW steering
SE under all sail Middle Part more moderate
Latter Part strong breeze from NW to E to S
Lat 41° 40' Long 126° 03'

128 Monday Dec 11th Commences with
fine weather and a fresh breeze from
NW steering SE under all sail Middle &
Latter Part much the same to E to S
Lat 43° 40' Long 130° 20' East
