

1844 Ship Unkas in the Pacific Ocean 1843
149 Days out

Monday January 1st 1844
This Day Commences with a new year
and a thick cloudy day and I am in hopes
it will be a lucky year with us and I think
it will be but it looks very dark to me but
never give it as long a guess goes and water runs
so we go with the wind NW heading NE by E
by the wind nothing in sight Middle Port
wind sailed to NW square the yards steering NE by E
Latter Part much the same the watch employed in
ships duty so ends my self sick with the tooth ache
Lat 36° 25' South Long 157° 30' West

150 Tuesday Jan 2^d
Commences with fine weather and
light winds from NW steering NE by E under all sail
Middle & Latter Part much the same nothing in sight
and is not like to be so ends this Day with the tooth ache
Lat 34° 30' S, Long 158° 00' West

151 Wednesday Jan 3^d
Commences with fine weather
and a fine breeze from NW steering NE by E
under all sail set in Middle & Latter part
much the same so ends this Day with the
tooth ache Lat 33° 19' Long 152° 10' W

Thursday Jan 4th
Commences with fine weather
and light winds from W to NW steering NE by E
Middle Port calm Latter Part light winds
from NW steering NE by E with all sail set
so ends this Day with the tooth ache and
Lat 32° 40' Long

153 Friday Jan 5th
Commences with fine weather
and light winds from NE heading NE by E
by the wind Middle & Latter Part much the
same so ends Lat 31° 50' S Long 151° 30'

154 Saturday Jan 6th
Commences with fine
weather and light winds from NE heading
NE by E by the wind Middle & Latter Part
much the same nothing in sight so ends
Lat 31° 47' South Long 150° 20' West

1844 Ship Unkas bound to the Sandwich Isl

155 Days out Sunday January 7th 1844
Commences with fine
weather and light winds from NE heading
NE by the wind Middle Port wind sailed to
NE by the wind Latter Part much
much the same so ends nothing in sight and is not
like to be thick and raining and little nor Sailing

156 Monday Jan 8th
Commences with thick and rainy
weather wind from S steering NE Middle Port
much the same Latter Part fine weather
and a fine breeze from SE steering NE with
all sail set so ends this Day nothing in sight
Lat 28° 42' Long 149° 30' West

157 Tuesday Jan 9th
Commences with fine
weather and a fine wind from SE Middle Port
variable winds Latter Part calm at 10 & 11
a light breeze from NE heading NE by E by
the wind so ends this Day
Lat 25° 45' South

158 Wednesday 10th
Commences with fine
weather and a light wind from NE heading
NE by the wind Middle & Latter
Part much the same so ends nothing
in sight the watch employed in ships duty
so Lat 20° Long to day

159 Thursday Jan 11th
Commences with thick
weather and light variable winds from all
round the house Middle & Latter Part much
the same ship heading any way from NE to E
so ends nothing in sight so goes it
Lat 25° 30' South Long 148° 33' W

160 Friday Jan 12th
Commences with thick
moderate weather and light winds from
NE steering NE by W Middle & Latter Part
much the same the watch employed in ships duty
so ends
