161 Days out Saturday Jan 13th Commences with light variable winds and calm with rain Middle Part the same Latter Part a fine breeze from NW ship under all sail heading N.W. by the wind 12 Ends this Day
Lat 24° 56' Long 147° 12' West

162 Sunday Jan 14th Commences with light variable winds from W by S ship under all sail heading S by the wind middle & Latter Part much the same so Ends
Lat 23° 09' S Long 146° 00' West

163 Monday 15th Commences with light winds from W heading S under all sail at 4 P.M. saw a sail to the leeward Middle & Latter Part much the same so Ends hot calm weather
Lat 21° 31' Long 146° 05'

164 Tuesday Jan 16th Commences with light variable winds from bear and thear ship heading S.W. by the wind Middle & Latter Part much the same the wind many whar and every whar but the right way
No Lat Long 145° 15' West

165 Wednesday Jan 17th Commences with fine weather and light winds from NW heading N.W. by the wind one sail in sight Middle & Latter Part much the same so Ends seeing nothing
Lat 20° 30' Long 146° 10' West

166 Thursday Jan 18th Commences with fine weather and light winds from NW heading N.W. by the wind one ship in sight at 4 P.M. saw sperm whales the other ships boats lowered and drove them off at 4 P.M. spoke the ship Citizen of Sag harbour 9 months out 300 lbs Middle & Latter Part fine weather nothing in sight so Ends and had times but never mind

1844 Ship Unear Bound to Baker town

167 Days out Friday Jan 19th Commences with fine weather and light winds from N.W. heading NW at 2 P.M. spoke the Citizen at 1 P.M. parted company Middle & Latter Part much the same so Ends got nothing
Lat 18° 26' South Long 146° 50' West

168 Saturday 20th Commences with fine breezes from E by S steering S by W under all sail at 5 P.M. saw the Land United bearing S.W. by N 40 miles Dist Middle Part much the same Latter Part fine weather at 8 A.M. saw the Island of Otahiti bound there to carry a sick man so Ends
Lat South Land 177° 00'

169 Sunday Jan 21th Commences with fine weather and a fine breeze steering W by N under all sail at 5 P.M. took top gallant sails Middle Part laying off and on to the latter Part the same at 8 P.M. the boat went on shore and at 10 came off again and carried the sick man to shore so Ends the boat a shore

170 Monday Jan 22th Commences with fine breeze from N.E. laying off and on the 1st of Otahiti at 5 P.M. the boat came off made all sail bound to the Sandwich Islands for recruits Middle & Latter Part much the same at sunrise saw sperm whales lowered all four boats and got 4 of them so Ends
Lat 16° 09' S Long 149° 30' West

171 Tuesday Jan 23th Commences with fine weather wind from E.S.E. steering by the wind employed in nothing at 5 P.M. finished Middle & Latter Part much the same at 9 A.M. started the works and went to boiling so Ends boiling
Lat 15° 28' South Long 149° 33' West

172 Wednesday Jan 24th Commences with equally weather wind from E.S.E. heading by the wind Middle & Latter Part the same employed in boiling
Lat 14° 34' South Long 149° 24' West
