

1844 Ship Uncas boys hard at it

332 Days out Sunday June 30th

Commences with fine weather and light winds from E ship under easy sail stowing down oil and brilling middle part much the same Latter Part fine weather so ends

333 Monday July 1st 1844

Commences with fine weather and a fresh breeze from N.E. middle and Latter Part thick and foggy saw one whale so ends Lat 45° 10'

334 Tuesday July 2^d

Commences with fine weather and thick fog light winds from N.W. middle and Latter Part much the same so ends saw several right whales Lat 46° 30'

335 Wednesday July 3^d

Commences with fine weather and light winds from N.W. middle and Latter Part thick and foggy saw several right whales so ends foggy Lat 46° 35' North

336 Thursday July 4th

Commences with fine weather at 2 P.M. saw whales lowered the Boat for them the W.B. struck him sign took him to the ship and commenced cutting middle and Latter Part much the same so ends

337 Friday July 5th

Commences with fine weather and light winds from W at 3 P.M. lowered the Boat for whales the B.B. struck one and got stove and the fine parted so away he went middle Part much the same Latter Part thick and foggy so ends this day got nothing

338 Saturday July 6th

Commences with thick foggy weather wind S.S.W. very light middle Part clearing of N.E. Latter Part fine weather at 6 P.M. saw the same whale once parted from on Friday lowered for him but did not get him the line fast to him so ends this day

1844 Ship Uncas in the fog hard up

339 Sunday July 7th

Commences with fine weather and light winds from S plenty of whales in sight at 2 P.M. lowered for one the B.B. struck him and took him to the ship and commenced cutting middle Part thick and foggy Latter Part fine weather at 3 P.M. commenced brilling so ends

340 Monday July 8th

Commences with thick foggy weather and light winds from W. Employed in brilling middle Part much the same Latter Part thick fog and bad weather so ends this day Lat 47° 42' N. 5° 40' W.

Tuesday July 9th

Commences with thick dirty weather wind from S.W. plenty of whales in sight thick fog did not lower for these middle and Latter Part the same so ends N.E. O.B.

Wednesday July 10th

Commences with thick dirty weather plenty of whales in sight middle and Latter Part the same hard old times but all

Thursday July 11th

Commences with thick foggy weather and light winds and calm plenty of whales middle and Latter Part the same Lat 47° 15' Long 157° 51' East

Friday July 12th

Commences with thick dirty weather and a fresh breeze from N.E. middle and Latter Part calm so ends saw whales thick fog

Saturday July 13th

Commences with thick weather at 2 P.M. lighted up saw 3 right whales at 3 shut down thick again middle and Latter Part calm and foggy so ends
