Thursday June 22nd 1845
Commenced with fine weather
and light winds from the NW at 6 AM took and anchored
and spread our canvas brimed out sail to catch the
breeze steering our course out of the port of New Bedford
and leaving a foaming track behind and every thing else
that is near and dear to us by the ties of nature those
that we hold as dear to us as our lives yes we must leave
them for how long we are not perhaps for life
