July 1 1830 First part fine weather latter rugged

latter part calm

2 Light breeze employed latter rugged

3 Calm pleasant weather Boats in Bay S.E.

4 Fresh and clear at 10 A.M. saw the north boats

towing a whale at along side

S.E.

5 First fine latter hazy saw nothing

S.E.

6 Fine weather saw nothing

7 Bristle winds at 9 A.M. saw south boats

towing a whale chased a whale

South

8 At 10 A.M. saw a whale close to the ship

chased without success

S.E.

9 Light winds saw nothing

North

10 Calm cloudy weather saw nothing

11 Light breeze & cloudy weather saw nothing S.E.

12 Fresh winds & fair weather saw nothing South

13 Calm hazy weather sent boats in Bay S.E.

14 Wind and weather very changeable at 10

North boats towing a whale anchored her

North

15 First strong winds latter moderate boiling

16 Bristle winds clear & rugged saw nothing

South

17 Light breeze cloudy & hazy

18 Clear & pleasant saw nothing

South

19 Light variable breeze

Pleasant saw two whales
