 fore part strong winds from SW
 laying under the lee of the land at
 at 9 spoke Brig Franklin of Providence
 to run 6 months 140 hbls middle and latter
 part strong gales from West still laying
 to the Eastward of Terceira one ship
 in company do ends

Wednesday Sept 14 1845
 fore part strong gales from West
 equally laying headed to the South
 the land 10 miles off middle and latter
 part strong winds and equally do ends

Thursday Sept 14 1845
 fore part moderate sun equally Terceira
 having about 10 miles at 1 PM exchanged
 signals with ship B. K. S. Henrietta heading
 W. S. W. by the wind middle and latter part
 moderate and fine weather in PM
 cooping oil and getting ready for
 landing do ends

Friday Sept 19
 fore part light winds from
 West fine in latter at 6 tracked
 to the South Pico 10 miles off
 middle part equally sun rain
 latter fine weather working up
 to Fozal find strong Southern
 current then two ships
 do ends

Saturday Sept 20 1845
 fore part fresh winds from the North
 at 9 AM backed in for Pico at 10 back the
 wind from E. & fine weather current
 setting to the SW middle and latter part
 moderate and fine weather variable
 winds heading in for Fozal do ends

Sunday Sept 21 1845
 fore part light winds from the
 SW fine at went on shore at
 Fozal returned in the time landed
 50 hbls Sperm Oil heading out the
 passage to the E. & E. mid and latter variable
 winds at daylight lay under the SE part
 of St George calm some rain do ends

Monday Sept 22 1845
 fore part strong wind from SW
 steering to the SE at 2 PM saw Sperm
 whale going quick to the windward
 toward two boats chased 6 mile no came
 up middle fresh wind fine weather
 laying headed to the SW mid and latter
 at 6 AM Steered SE by at Madeira
 Steered South by West do ends
 Lat 34 " 48 N
 Long 26 " 17 W

Tuesday Sept 23
 fore part strong winds from the
 North steering N by W per compass
 mid and latter strong winds from
 West steering N by W do ends
 Lat 35.43 N
 Long 25 " 40 W
