all this day squally and variable
plenty of rain some thunder spoke
the Aboram 21 masted 60 days from
van Breda no oil
Lat 4.03 N
Long 22.15 W

Monday Oct 13
all this day strong winds from
the South in company with the
Aboram 21 but her sailing like mine
the Ohio at 4 tacked to the West
Lat 4.04 N
Long 21.40 W

Tuesday Oct 14
all this day fine weather heading
to West at 4 tacked to the East several
sail in sight at 6 AM tacked to
the West So Ends
Lat 6.34 N
Long 22.00 W

Wednesday Oct 15
all this day light winds and variable
making very slow head way So
Lat 6.19 N
Long 21.00 W

Thursday Oct 16
all this day fine weather light
airs from the West West quarter
heading to the SE So Ends
Lat 7.00 N
Long 20.43 W

Friday Oct 17 1843
commenced with light airs from the
SW heading SE by S middle and latter
part light airs and variable one ship
in sight
Lat 8.32 N
Long 19.00 West

Saturday Oct 18th
Commenced fine weather at 6 squally
wind westerly some rain heading
South by the wind middle and
latter strong winds heading SE at 10 AM
saw a sperm whale two sightings
and lost the run of him never saw
him more So Ends
Lat 5.48 S
Long 18.20 W

Sunday Oct 19
fore part strong wind from
the SE at 6 tacked to the NW
middle and latter part fresh winds
from the SE sail in sight
Lat 4.50 N
Long 18.47 W

Monday Oct 20th
fore part fresh winds from the SE
heading to the SW by the wind 3
sail in sight fine weather all sail
trimmed to the breeze mid and latter
part light winds and variable
Lat 3.37 N
Long 19.34

Tuesday Oct 21st
All this day moderate at 6 AM tacked
to the SE saw several sail So Ends
So this day
Long 19.00 W
