Commences with fresh winds from  
SSE heading SE by the wind  
at 8 tacked to the NW equally so ends  
Lat 2<sup>o</sup> 39' N  
Long 19<sup>o</sup> 46' W

Thursday Oct 23<sup>rd</sup>  
Commences fine weather at 3  
PM tacked to the SE. Several sails in  
sight mid and latter part fine breeze  
from the SSE heading to the SW  
Lat 1<sup>o</sup> 24' N  
Long 20<sup>o</sup> 14' W

Friday Oct 24<sup>th</sup>  
Fore part moderate and fine  
weather heading SW by W by the wind  
3 sail in sight mid and latter part  
moderate and fine weather steering  
SSE per cam  
Lat 00 34 South  
Long 21<sup>o</sup> 45' W

Saturday Oct 25<sup>th</sup>  
all this day fine weather and  
briak trades heading to the SW by the  
wind all sail trimmed to the breeze  
Lat 2<sup>o</sup> 31' S  
Long 23<sup>o</sup> 36' W

Sunday Oct 26<sup>th</sup>  
all this day fine weather fresh  
winds from SE steering SW by S  
Lat 5<sup>o</sup> 11' S  
Long 24<sup>o</sup> 45' W

Monday Oct 27<sup>th</sup> 1845  
all this day fine weather and  
strong breezes from SE steering  
SW by S employed painting the boats  
Lat 7<sup>o</sup> 58' S  
Long 26<sup>o</sup> 06' W

Tuesday Oct 28<sup>th</sup>  
all this day fine weather steering  
SW by S mid and latter fresh trades  
all sail trimmed to the breeze  
Lat 10 50 S  
Long 27<sup>o</sup> 15' W

Wednesday Oct 29<sup>th</sup>  
all this day fine weather winds  
from SSE one sail in sight so ends  
Lat 13<sup>o</sup> 39' S  
Long 28<sup>o</sup> 40' W

Thursday Oct 30<sup>th</sup>  
All this day fine weather  
one ship in sight at daylight  
steamed SW commences breaking out  
betwene decks and over hollung shakes  
SE  
Lat 16<sup>o</sup> 02' S  
Long 29<sup>o</sup> 50' W

Friday Oct 31<sup>st</sup>  
all this day still at work betwene  
decks at 8 steamed off finished at  
7 commenced skathing the deck in  
the maste so ends  
Lat 18 18 S  
Long 30 31 W
