fore part light winds from the
North Steaming SSW impeded sheathing
the Deck mid and latter part
moderate same equal So Ends
Lat 19° 10' N
Long 31° 15' W

Sunday Nov 2d
fore part fresh wind same
equal at night moderate mid
and latter part variable some rain
Steaming SSW
Lat 18° 00' N
Long 31° 00' W

Monday Nov 3d
fore part moderate equal at 4 PM
hoisted the Archila of Harve put down
letters on board for America mid and
latter part strong winds from the
North
Lat 18° 01' N
Long 30° 10' W

Tuesday Nov 4th
fore part fine weather same a
bark Steaming SSW mid and latter
part fine weather Steaming SSW
Lat 18° 31' N
Long 31° 00' W

Wednesday Nov 5
all this day fine weather fresh wind
from NE at 4 PM saw sperm whale
aboard chased without success So Ends
Lat 17° 11' N
Long 31° 10' W

Thursday Nov 6th 1845
fore part strong winds from north
Steaming SSW middle strong winds from
NW same rain latter heavy rain at 10 AM
wind shifted to the south So Ends
Lat 19° 19' N
Long 31° 15' W

Friday Nov 7th
fore part fresh wind from SSW
heading SE by the wind at 4 PM tacked
to the West wind inclining to the East
took in topgallant sails So Ends
Lat 30° 49' N
Long 35° 40' W

Saturday Nov 8th
fore part fresh winds from the
East Steaming SSW mid and latter
part strong wind from the East Steaming
SSW saw one bale Steaming to the NE. So
Lat 32° 11' N
Long 38° 11' W

Sunday Nov 9th
fore part strong wind from the
East Steaming SSW at 6 PM Steamed S by NW
single reefed mid and latter part strong
wind more southerly heading off SSW by the
wind
Lat 34° 37' N
Long 40° 04' W
