 to the ESE. seen rain strong breeze SE.

Sunday Dec 30
 fore part strong winds from the
 ESE steering N by E saw plenty of
 finbacks mid and latter part fine
 breezes from the East steering NW
 Lat 39.23
 Long 45.46 W

Monday 31 Dec 45
 fore part fresh winds from ESE steering
 NW by W saw plenty of feed and finbacks
 middle and latter strong wind from
 ESE steering SW
 Lat 40.42 S
 Long 48.21 W

Tuesday Dec 1
 all this day thick fog and same rain
 and thunder winds from West to NW
 steering SW light sails all in

Wednesday Dec 2
 fore part light winds from the
 NW thick fog and same rain middle
 and to moderate thick at 4 wind shifted
 to the South backed to collect strong
 winds at Maricao reefed 3 ends
 Lat 41.23 S
 Long 51.10 W

Thursday Dec 3 1845
 fore part strong winds from
 the South at 3 more moderate let out
 reefs set main & g sail at 4 wind on SW
 backed to the South middle moderate at
 4 PM wind on steering SW heavy breeze
 took in sail to a boat reefed in 3 sail
 and reefed fore sail heading SW
 Lat 42.04 S
 Long 52.50 W

Friday Dec 4
 fore part heavy gales from NW
 at 6 more ship to the NW in fore sail
 lay them to twenty four fathoms high
 sea and heavy squalls so ends
 Lat 42.08 S
 Long 54.00 W

Saturday Dec 5
 commences heavy gales from NW
 laying headed high sea running
 middle strong winds at 1 PM let double
 reefed topsails and reef fore sail latter
 more moderate all sail out backed to
 the South at 6 PM so ends
 Lat 42.01 S
 Long 53.54 W

Sunday Dec 6
 fore part moderate winds from
 NW steering SW fine weather mid
 and latter part the same steering
 SW
 Lat 43.10 S
 Long 53.40 W
