Commenced with fresh winds from south at 3 PM returned with 400 lbs water and 400 lbs of fish took in the water headed over for Mafesera middle and latter part fresh breezes from south saw several ships at 6 saw the island at Mafesera here south 8 miles

fore part fresh winds from south steering W by N mid and latter part moderate winds from SE steering to the westward

Saturday Feb. 17

fore part strong trades employed sailing the fore rigging steering W by N mid and latter moderate and fine weather at work on the rigging

Sunday Feb. 18

fore part strong breezes from the East fine weather mid and latter part moderate and fine weather steering W by N

Monday Feb. 19

fore part light airs from the East steering W by N mid and latter part light airs from the SE employed sailing rigging and steering

Tuesday Feb. 20

all this day fresh breezes from the East steering W by N per compass
