

Wednesday April 29th 1846
 fore part strong wind from the
 West cloudy heading North by the West
 at 6 came down from West head
 and in fore top sail middle fresh wind
 from the West at daylight set double
 reefed 3 sails at 9 AM wind SE snowing
 thick in all sail have true heading
 to the East
 Lat 50° 20'
 Long 149° 00'

Thursday April 30th
 fore part strong Gale from SE rain
 very bad weather middle and latter part
 strong winds from the South thick fog
 laying head to the W
 Lat 51° 10'
 Long 149° 30'

Friday April 1st 1846
 fore part strong winds from the South
 thick fog mid and latter part heavy
 Gale from SW heavy squalls of wind
 snow and hail so ends Lat 50° 50'
 Long 149° 22'

Saturday May 2nd
 fore part heavy Gale from the
 SW laying head to the SE & W
 heavy squalls plenty of snow
 middle and latter part strong Gale from
 SW laying head to the SE high sea
 running so ends Lat 51° 13'
 Long 148° 52' W

Sunday May 3rd 1846
 fore part heavy Gale from SW
 inclining to moderate wind bearing
 to the South East reefed main
 top sail and reefed fore sail mid and latter
 part strong Gale and a heavy swell, inclining
 to moderate at 9 am a right whale hauled
 and drove him to the windward so ends
 Lat 51° 50' W
 Long 148° 38' W

Monday May 4th
 all this day light airs and variable
 heavy swell nothing in sight but a
 few finbacks so ends Lat 52° 18' W
 Long 149° 13' W

Tuesday May 5th
 fore part light airs from the North
 at 4 PM in sail headed to the SE
 middle part calm latter light airs at daylight
 light whale very near the ship
 and chased him at 6 saw three more
 and struck two sunbake and cut
 down the other after being fast 4 hours
 (80) hbls cut the rope May 148° 41' W
 180 hbls

Wednesday May 6th
 fore part fresh winds from the South
 at 3 PM spoke the fishing Elizabeth
 of New London 11 months 1100 middle
 strong winds from the South sun rain latter
 part wind SW clear weather at 4 set single
 reefed 3 sails at 7 more to the East steered
 by 8 nothing in sight Lat 54° 59' W
 Long 147° 36' W
