

Wednesday June 3rd 1846
 fore part strong Gale from East
 rain at midnight moderate wind
 started to the west more ship to the
 SE foggy so ends
 Lat 52° 30'
 Long 148° 45'

Thursday June 4th
 fore part fresh winds from SE
 at 2 PM hauled for three right whale
 Galed them all no get mid and
 latter part fine weather. Sun fog
 Lat 52° 15'
 Long 149° 41'

Friday June 5th
 all this day moderate winds from
 the West at 10 PM caught a whale
 at mariners took him to the ship
 Lat 53° 02'
 Long 147° 25'

Saturday June 6th
 fore part fresh winds from the
 at 6 finished cutting right small
 an harque in sight hailing
 mid and latter part strong wind
 employed scraping haw so ends
 Lat 54° 26'

Sunday June 7th
 all this day strong winds from
 the SE at 7 PM a boat from the
 Dutch ship Stahita came on board
 at 10 returned back to the ship
 the wind employed hailing so ends
 Lat 52° 45'

Monday June 8th 1846
 fore part fine weather at
 2 PM hauled for a right whale struck
 and lost the line at 6 in sail
 thick fog mid and latter part
 strong Gale from the SE stopped
 hailing and in fore sail
 took the line
 so ends

Tuesday June 9th 1846
 fore part strong winds from SE heavy
 Gale mid and latter part the same
 Lat 53° 45'
 Long 147° 00'

Wednesday June 10th
 all this day heavy Gale with
 rain wind from SE

Thursday June 11th
 all this day strong winds from
 the SE employed hailing at
 11 PM finished hailing and
 more ship to the west and ship
 in sight
 Lat 53° 50'

Friday July 1st
 all this day strong winds employed
 staining oil at 6 finished so ends
 latter part light wind seen
 equally
 so ends
