Friday June 26th
fine part calm but 3 toward
and caught a whale at 4 took
him to the ship at 6 AM commenced
cutting at 11 finished Lat 51 " 54

Saturday June 27th
all this day fine weather stowing
down and hailing spoke the
Higer of New Bedford 1900 blks
Lat 51 " 10

Sitting up Shooks

Sunday June 28th 1846
all this day fine weather and calm
nothing in sight of the whale kind
in company with the Higer
employed sitting up Shooks and
hailing do end Lat 51 " 30

Monday June 29th
all this day fine weather spoke
the Acme of Fishery 2300 blks
at the Mactaquana dam Bedford
2400 do Lat

Tuesday June 30th
all this day moderate and foggy employ
hailing stowing oil 32 spoke the
Hamilton of Sag Harbour 1000 blks
Lat 52 " 01

Wednesday June 1st
all this day variable plenty of
fog employed stowing oil
at 7 finished strong winds and
fog

Thursday July 1st
all this day thick fog winds
southerly very disagreeable weather
and no whales do Lat
