 fore part moderate and fine weather
 all sail trimmed to the breeze mid
 and latter part light airs from
 South
 Lat 00° 06' N
 Long 84° 26' W

Wednesday Sept 2^d
 fore part moderate and cloudy
 weather middle and latter part
 moderate and fine weather
 heading Eastward by the wind
 Lat 34° 18' N
 Long 86° 14' W

Thursday Sept 3^d
 fore part moderate cloudy
 at 4 saw blackfish forward
 at 8 3 mid and latter part
 fine weather saw blackfish
 toward got nothing so ends
 Lat 1° 00' N
 Long 84° 36' W

Friday Sept 4th
 fore part fine weather all sail
 at mid and latter part fresh
 winds from the South
 No Lat
 Long 83° 04' W

Saturday Sept 5th
 all this day moderate winds from
 SW heading SE
 Lat 2° 16' N
 Long 81° 32' W

Sunday Sept 6th 1846
 fore part fine weather and no fish
 mid and latter part moderate and
 fine weather at 10 PM raised the
 band to the South of Sumner spoke
 the Muntrop 26 months 1000 lbs
 Lat 03° 44' N
 5 miles from land

Monday Sept 7th
 fore part moderate Sun down in
 sight of the ships at anchor - home
 to head off shore for the night
 at day light headed in for the anchorage
 at 10 came to in 4 fathoms so ends

Tuesday Sept 8th
 employed in giling the raft in to
 river for water mid and latter part
 fine weather at 9 PM took the final
 raft in an deck so ends

Wednesday Sept 9th
 commences fine weather employed
 giling off water and SC got an
 observation found the chronometer
 to be right so ends

Thursday Sept 10th
 fore part fine weather and water
 gave to town and liberty received the
 recruits on board in a large keel
 from the shore latter part fine
 weather so ends
