all this day fine weather cloudy  
plenty of bumpback in sight - heading  
SW by the wind all sail out

Tuesday Sept 15

all this day fine weather all sail  
set heading SW by the wind do end

Wednesday Sept 16

all this day fine weather nothing  
seen yet steering to the South  
by the wind the watch employed  
in the hold about the ship

Thursday Sept 17 1846

all this day fine weather heading  
SW by the wind all sail out do end

all this day strong trade and same  
generally steering to the South by the wind

all this day fine more moderate

all this day fine weather and strong

weather do ends
