

Saturday Oct 3rd 1846
 fore part strong winds from ESE
 at 3 more to the South double reef
 to sails and courses same rain
 mid and latter strong gales from the
 East heading to the South thick weather

Sunday Oct 4th
 fore part strong winds from
 East cloudy weather heading South
 double reef to main sail in mid
 and latter more moderate wind East
 cloudy all reef out Lat 37° 33' S
 Long 85° 04' W

Monday Oct 5th
 fore part fresh winds from the
 East heading to the South by the wind
 begin to raise the hoods plenty mid and
 latter part moderate and variable
 backed ship several times so ends
 Lat 38° 44' S
 Long 84° 00' W

Tuesday Oct 6th
 fore part fine weather winds SE
 all sail out and trimmed by the wind
 mid and latter part moderate winds from
 the South and East Lat 38° 45' S
 Long 88° 11' W

Wednesday Oct 7th
 fore part moderate and fine weather
 wind backing from ESE to SSE
 mid and latter part calm and light
 air Lat 38° 21' S
 Long 86° 48' W

Thursday Oct 8th 1846
 fore part calm at 4 a small breeze
 from the West Steady ESE all sail
 out mid and latter part fresh winds
 from WNW cloudy weather so ends
 Lat 39° 18' S
 Long 88° 04' W

Friday Oct 9th
 fore part strong winds from WNW
 cloudy Steady ESE sent down fore
 50 yard and raise the rigging &c
 middle strong winds from SW rain
 at 11 PM wind shifted to SW blowing hard
 in all sail but abast reefed main & sail
 and fore sail strong squalls so ends
 Lat 40° 42' S
 Long 89° 00' W

Saturday Oct 10th
 fore part strong winds from the SW
 heading ESE by the wind double reefed & sail
 mid and latter part moderate wind inclining
 to the West all sail out so ends
 Lat 41° 10' S
 Long 81° 19' W

Sunday Oct 11th
 fore part strong winds from the SW cloudy
 Steady East middle part strong winds from
 SW rain latter strong winds from W Steady
 by S at midnight cleared off so ends
 Lat 42° 00' S
 Long 78° 06' W
