 fore part strong gales and heavy
 squalls high sea running
 middle and latter strong gales inclining
 to the West at daylight set the fore sail
 more to the South so ends
 Lat 44 " 03
 Long 79 " 20

Saturday Nov 30 16 months
 fore part strong gales from the West
 at 6 in fore sail more to the
 SW thick and raining middle more
 moderate at 5 made sail and broad for
 whales caught one at 4 took him to the
 ship some foggy
 Lat 45 " 49
 Long 77 " 30

Sunday Nov 1st
 fore part moderate winds from SW
 same foggy spoke the Rembrock at
 8 Landah 17 months 100 bls mid and
 latter part moderate winds from the
 SW same foggy spoke the Crozele at 10 spoke
 13 months 1300 so ends
 Lat 43 " 44
 Long 77 " 30

Monday Nov 30 1846
 fore part fresh winds from the SW
 in company with Crozele
 no whales in sight mid and latter part
 moderate winds from SW fine weather
 employed showing oil so ends
 Lat 43 " 30
 Long 77 " 20

Tuesday Dec 1st
 all this day fine weather wind southerly
 in company with ship James Munn
 at night in sail more to the West
 some ships in sight no whale but
 finbacks
 Lat 43 " 28
 Long 77 " 12

Wednesday Dec 2nd
 fore part moderate and fine
 weather nothing in sight employed
 lifting up 18 hooks middle moderate and
 fine weather heading to the NE double
 reefed latter part strong winds from
 South at midnight in sail
 Lat 44 " 16
 Long 77 " 06

Thursday Dec 3rd
 fore part strong gales from South
 heading SW by W under short sail
 mid and latter part strong winds
 from South spoke the Kantakot
 12 months 1,600 bls
 Lat 44 " 10
 Long 78 " 00
