

Remarks of Transactions
on Board Barque
Atlantic of New Bedford
off River St. Laplatte Lat 37° 18' S.
Dec 25th 1851 Long 49° 00' W

105
Saturday December 25th 1851
commenced fine weather and
fresh breezes from NW at 4 spoke
the bark. At 4 o'clock 150 hbls sperm mid and latter part
fine weather winds from NW
saw several sails steering to the S.W.
the Alt in company nothing
seen of the whale kind

Lat 37° 18' S
Long 49° 00' W

Sunday Dec 26th 1851
some part fine weather mid
from NW at 4 in sail for the
night in hopes of the morning saw
a brig steering SW mid part calm
latter strong winds from NW
at 6 AM looked to the west under sails
needed topsails

Lat 36° 35'
Long 49° 40'

Saturday Dec 27th 1851
some part strong winds from
NW at 4 in sail for the night
at sunset in sail for the night
mid moderate thick latter heavy small
fine lastly steering NW

Lat 36° 09' S
Long 49° 08' W

Sunday Dec 28th 1851
some part fresh winds from
SE steering NW at 4 in sail mid and latter
part fresh winds from the east
cloudy heading to the north

Lat 35° 08' N
Long 50° 08' W
