 one at 3 PM took him to the ship.
 strong wind and high sea heavy rain
 mid and latter heavy Gale from East
 at daylight wind changed to the South
 at 4 commenced cutting heavy
 swell had cutting
 Lat 34 " 09
 Long 48 " 00

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 Friday Feb 21 1852
 fore part moderate winds very
 high swell cutting at finished the Body
 and left the hie in hopes of better
 weather but in the morning more
 backed to the hie at 9 finished cleared
 the decks commenced Bailing
 strong Gale
 Lat 34 " 27
 Long 47 " 36

Sunday Feb 22
 strong Gale heavy sea Bailing
 mid and latter part more moderate
 at noon but blowing strong yet
 Lat 34 " 09
 Long 47 " 40

Monday Feb 23
 fore part strong winds from SW
 inclining to moderate mid and latter
 part fine weather at noon
 finished Bailing three sail in sight
 Lat 34 " 59
 Long 48 " 00

Tuesday Feb 24
 fore part fine weather heading
 to the SW wind South mid and
 latter part fine weather in play
 strong Gail
 Lat 34 " 20
 Long 48 " 00

Wednesday Feb 25 1852
 fore part fresh winds from East some
 weather at night in sail nothing in
 sight mid and latter part fresh winds
 from East in play strong Gail
 Lat 34 " 40
