Commences light airs and fine weather
steering SE by E all sail out trimmed
to the breeze mid calm latter light airs
from the employed painting ship
latter steering SE by E are being in
light shamed English coaulars so ESE

Friday April 23rd
fine weather wind from SE steering
SE by E nothing seen yet mid and latter
fresh winds from SE
Lat 18 " 10 S
Long 81 " 40 W

Saturday April 24th
all this day fine breezes from south
steering SE by E all sail out nothing in
Lat 15 " 40 S
Long 81 " 30 W

Sunday May 1st
all this day fresh breezes and fine
weather steering SE by E latter part strong
breezes same rain
Lat 14 " 30 S
Long 81 " 14 W

Monday May 2nd
Commences strong winds from East squally
rain at 1 P.M. 2 Breezes in sight mid and
latter part strong trades and squally so ESE
Lat 9 " 44 S
Long 80 " 21 W
