Wednesday May 30  
all this day trades from East by

Thursday May 31  
all this day fine weather light winds  
from the ESE so ends  
Lat 24 " 28 W  
Long 50 " 51 W

Friday May 1  
all this day fine weather light winds  
from ESE steaming to the north by the  
wind  
Lat 30 " 00 W  
Long 51 " 31 W

Saturday May 2  
all this day fine weather winds easterly  
heading to the north  
Lat 31 " 28 W  
Long 52 " 20 W

Sunday May 3  
commence light winds and fine weather  
nothing seen yet but live in hopes  
mid and latter part calm setting up rising  
fine weather  
Lat 32 " 19 W  
Long 52 " 10 W
