all this day fine weather  
latt 35. 27  
long 50. 06

Tuesday Dec 7

Dec 8. 1852

latt 34. 18 long 50. 43  
saw one large whale  
blow came on & blew took  
up the boats we saw the submarine

Dec 9. 1852

latt 34. 50 long 50. 20  
saw one large whale going  
puck to the N.E. toward coast  
came up
