Wednesday Jan 6 1858
Commences calm at 4 took the breeze
from SSW steered to the SW by the wind
at 7 in dale for the night Oh dear
no whales yet mid and latter part
fine weather and calm at 8 took
a breeze from the north headed
to the west by the wind

Thursday Jan 7. 1858
Commences fresh winds from
the north at 1 P.M. Spoke the Bark
Montana 19 months 3/4 at 7 in
dale for the night mid and latter
part strong winds from the ^{west} incline
to the south at daylight set double
topsails steered S by E

Friday Jan 8 1858
Strong breeze from the SSW
steered NNE at 4 came to the wind
on the Eastern tack at 7 in dale
for the night nothing seen yet
lik whales Oh dear. middle fine
weather latter calm two whaling
Barks in sight

Saturday Jan 9 1858
calm fine weather at 7 double
reefed mid and latter part fine breeze
from NNE heading to the west by
the wind Green water

NNE heading to the west at 7 in
dale for the night Oh dear no
no whales mid fine same rain
latter fine weather at 9 spoke the
Emma. C. Jones 2300 blts all told

Monday Jan 11. 1858
fine part fine weather winds from
the SE heading to the SSW by the wind
in company with Emma C mid and
latter part calm and light airs

Lat 37. 04

Tuesday Jan 12 1858
light winds from the SE fine
weather heading to the west at
7 in dale for the night middle
and latter part moderate and fine at
11 Am shall draw two Right board
and reefed rat faster went off to the
SW
