

Remarks Log Grand Bank

Wednesday Jan 13 1858
Commences light air calm & E at 4
in 56 fathoms water mid and
latter part light air and calm
No bls Satt 36 40.20
Long 54.00

Thursday Jan 14 1858
thick fog and calm at 3 PM
lighted up Emma C. Jones in depth
three miles dist 56 fathoms and
and latter part moderate winds from
the East same foggy Satt 36 26
Long 53 40

Friday Jan 15 1858
fine weather steaming to the SSE
by the wind Emma C. Jones in slight
fog in 56 let the bls run no bottom
mid some thunder at 5 saw sperm
whale toward caught one
Satt 36 40
Long 53 40

Saturday Jan 16 1858
Commences fine weather light winds
from the north at 1 PM took the whale
to the ship got dinner and cut him in
spoke the Emma C. Jones she caught
a whale at the same time mid and
latter moderate variable no ends
Satt 36 32
Long 53 25

Station off River, Dr. Lapata 151

Sunday Jan 17 1858
British Breeze from the north heading
to the NE by the wind at 2 PM saw sperm
whales toward whale went to windward
took up the boats none ship whales turned
& toward 1 at 4 toward struck one down
the four struck another took the line
came back up the boats in 56
for the night employed bailing mid
squally sun thunder latter strong winds
from south clear weather
Satt 36 52
Long 53 33

Monday Jan 18 1858
Strong winds from south fine weather
had seen at 5 saw a small lot of very small
sperm whale toward could not fasten
mid and latter part fine weather variable
winds no ends
Satt 36 52
Long 53 40

Tuesday Jan 19 1858
Commences fine weather wind to the north
at 4 changed to the south in a squall
in all 56 none ship to the west
mid and latter strong winds from
south headed to the west
Satt 36 16
Long 54 16

Wednesday Jan 20
Strong wind southerly at 4 PM
succeeded 12 fathoms none ship
to the East at 7 in 56 mid and
latter fine weather winds from west
70 fathoms water
Satt 36 14
Long 53 18
