 to the South Lat 40. 10

Thursday Feb 11^d 1858
 Commences fine breeze from N.E.
 steering S.W. at 4 in Sale steered
 to the S.W. mid strong winds from
 N.E. latter fresh winds and fog
 Lat 40. 41
 Long 56. 38 at 3 P.M.

Friday Feb 12^d 1858
 steering S.W. saw foggy at 4 in
 Sale sounded 59 fathoms wore ship
 steered S.E. by E mid and latter part light
 airs and calm thick fog
