

Remarks on Board Bark

Sunday Feb 11 1858
fine weather wind from south
heading to the west by the wind
at night in dale as usual no whales
yet time going off middle calm
latter fresh winds from NW fine weather
Lat 40. 58
Long 56. 03

Monday Feb 15 1858
Strong winds from the NW distant
receded at 6 in dale took in the
fore sail by head to the west middle
strong winds from the NW
latter part more moderate heading
to the west all dale out
Lat 41. 28
Long 55. 03

Tuesday Feb 16 1858
Commence strong winds from
the north at night in dale head
to the west least reefed main
top sail and main Spencer fore
topmast staysail middle strong
gale from the north latter strong
winds same thick set the fore top sail
at 9 took it in again
Lat 41. 45 by DR
Long 56. 26

Wednesday Feb 17
Strong winds from north at 6 calm
mid light airs latter part fresh winds
from south steering NW
Lat 41. 31 Long 56. 41

Station off River S. Laplatas 1858

Thursday Feb 18
Strong winds from south heading
NW at night in dale dounded no
bottom mid and latter part fine
weather winds from the south saw
compasses kellers plenty of birds
and fish but no whales
at 5 PM in fathoms Lat 39. 34
steered east etc Long 55. 26 55. 08
at meridian no bottom

Friday Feb 19 1858
fine weather heading NW abundance
of birds and fish at night in
dale left the main top sail hole
mid calm latter light winds from NW
went down fore topgallant yard and mast
heading to the NE by the wind
Lat 38. 46
Long 54. 49 54. 40

Saturday Feb 20 1858
light winds from NW heading to
the NE by the at night in dale middle
and latter part fine weather light
breeze from the north steering
to the NE by the wind
Lat 38. 16
Long 54. 15 54. 24

Sunday Feb 21 1858
fine weather light winds from
NW head to the NE by the wind bright
& clear fish mid and latter fine weather
wind from north at meridian ticked
to the W Lat 38. 21 Long 53. 18
53. 40
