Strong winds from the West heading
to the East by the wind at night in
dawn no whales yet seen. Calm
mid strong wind from the North
latter part moderate high swell calm
and light air variable

Tuesday Feb 28th 1858
Calm and clear light squalls variable
at night in dawn high swell mid strong
gale from the West at 3 PM more
ship to the East took in the fore sail
latter part strong gale high sea at
10 Moderate set the topsails wind
still to the North

Wednesday Feb 29th
Strong winds from the West
squally at 3 moderate very heavy
swell at night in dawn mid and
latter part moderate winds and
very high swell heading to the
North by the wind

Thursday Feb 29th 1858
high swell light wind from the
the West at night in dawn head to the East
mid and latter part light air
and calm

Station off River de Lapata

Friday Feb 28th 1858
Calm very pleasant at night in
dawn at 10 moderate wind and latter
part moderate winds from the West
heading North nothing seen yet

Saturday Feb 29th
fine breeze from the North heading
to the West by the wind saw a ship
steering South at night in dawn no
sawal mid and latter strong
breeze from the North squally all
dawn with heading to the West

Lat 38. 25 by 2. 10
Long 54. 00

Sunday Feb 29th 1858
fore part strong breeze from
the North thick fog at night
in dawn head to the West mid
and latter part strong winds from
the North heading to the West
by the wind at 4 PM saw a ship

Monday March 1st 1858
Strong winds at night in dawn head
to the East no whales yet mid wind
from North at mid from South
lightning latter calm again
