

Remarks on Board Bark

Monday July 27th 1858
Spirally and Rainy till in the light
chased gave up going in with the
boats for the day at night double
reefed mid and latter part spirally at
9 went in with three boats chased two
whales could not fasten the end

Tuesday July 28th
Strong wind and spirally at 4 boats
came on board caught a few fish
middle wind from S.E. latter part calm

Wednesday July 29th
Calm the jelland having about
10 miles mid and latter part
moderate variable spirally
cracked the rib at it belwends

Thursday July 30th
Fresh wind from S.E. standing
over for the racks at 8 tacked
to the S.W. 10 miles from the racks
mid and latter part fine weather

Friday July 31st
Fine weather wind from the
S.E. at 10 miles sent in three
boats to the racks found nothing
there mid and latter part fine
weather at 8 went on shore
found lots of all kinds of trap
from the rack saw one
dog do end

Stuvia off Trinidad

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Saturday July 31st 1858
fine weather chased humphreys
came very near fastening at 8
came to the ship mid and latter part
moderate and sun spirally the boats
in chasing humphreys

Sunday July 1st
light wind and spirally at 5 P.M. the
boats returned to the ship found
the whales very wild could not
fasten mid and latter part fine
weather saw a large ship steering
to the south at 9 went in with
the boats do end this day

Monday July 2nd
commenced fine weather at 4 saw
spirally at 4 boats returned without
any whale middle fine weather at
8 went in with the boats at 9 started
a humphrey from the group and lost
the whale do end this day

Tuesday July 3rd
fine weather at 1 P.M. the
boats gave for the day in hopes of the
morning mid and latter part fine
weather at 8 went in with the boats
saw but the whales then very wild
do end this day

Wednesday July 4th
at 4 the boats returned no whale
yet mid and latter fine weather at 8 went
in with the boats took the anchors and
one chain from the rack on the island
