

Remarks on Peart Bank

Thursday July 29 1858
Fine weather employed taking off
the huckers - the post moderate
clean in W.R. at this day

Friday July 30
fine weather the current on shore
was liberty middle and latter part
fine weather the boats went and returned
to and from the shore several times
during the day

Saturday July 31st
Commenced fine weather at 4 the
boats returned with the last at
2 40 fathoms at 10 40 there
saw a large ship striking on
mid and lower part of each Reefed
from N E spoke a large Dutch
ship Bound to Batavia & Ende

Sunday August 7th
Strong winds from the N.E.
The S. Bats. on shore, on liberty
at 8 returned. mid and latter part
moderate and fine weather laying
off and on So End

Monday Aug 9.
fine weather and light winds from
the East mid and latter part
moderate and calm employed
blowing away the brush and charcoal
that came from the wreck.
So Ends

Stearns August 3^d 1858
light airs and calm pleasant. The
ice and ten miles Basin S.E.
middle and latter part light airs and
calm S. E. winds

Wednesday Aug 14th.
Commenced fine weather light and
at 3 sent a Boat along side of the Bark
Adelaide and 24 days from London
Barrard to Swan River had one lady
~~Passage~~ Passanger with 4 Children going
to A. Hushan & Barker that must be
Pleasant at 8 in the Evening went
on Board of the English Bark Quilon
from London Barrard to the Coast of
Africa had 16 Passangers men, women
and Children

Thursday Aug 5th
fine weather. light winds and calm
the Island 8 miles dist middle
and latter part moderate saw two
Sals. No Ends

Friday Aug 6th
Commences fine weather wind from
the East very moderate at 6 o'clock
in light Sals about in the place and
bearing East mid and latter part
moderate and fine weather
at 8 hrs sent in the Seal for
Whale & 20 Loads
