

Remarks on Board Boat

Saturday Aug 7th 1858
 fine weather at 3 PM struck
 and killed a whale & took him to
 the ship. headed off & hove the island
 three miles distant bearing S by
 mid and latter part moderate
 and fine weather at 11 finished
 cutting

Sunday Aug 8th
 commenced fine weather at
 1 PM spoke the Ocean Rover
 of Nantucket 37 months 1844
 employed Bailing middle and
 latter part fresh winds from S
 So Ends

Monday Aug 9th
 fresh winds and squally in company
 with the Ocean Rover at 6 finished
 Bailing whale made 50 hbls mid
 and latter part strong winds from
 rain at 8 AM parted with the
 shore ship she left for home

Tuesday Aug 10th
 strong winds from the S & S.W.
 rain at 4 headed in for the land
 mid and latter fresh breezes at 8
 went in with the Boats So Ends

Wednesday Aug 11th
 fine weather at 4 returned with
 the Boats no whale today mid and
 latter part fresh breezes at 8 struck
 a whale and lost him So Ends

Statera off Greenland

Thursday Aug 12th 1858
 fresh winds from S.W. at 6 came
 to the ship without any whale
 middle and latter part squally rain
 not got weather to go in with the
 Boats So Ends

Friday Aug 13th
 fresh winds from the East clear
 hope for a moderate day tomorrow
 mid and latter sun squally went
 in with the Boats saw but few
 whales So Ends

Saturday Aug 14th
 fresh breezes from the East fine
 weather at 4 the Boats returned without
 but success mid and latter part
 strong winds from the S.W. at
 6 commenced stowing down So Ends

Sunday Aug 15th
 fine weather employed stowing
 oil in the main hatch mid and
 latter part fine weather winds from
 S.W. at midnight coast in with the Boats
 saw no whales So Ends

Monday Aug 16th
 fine weather winds S.W. heading in
 for the island mid and latter part
 moderate and fine weather went
 in with the Boats saw no
 whale So Ends
