

Friday Aug 28 1858
Commences light airs and calm the Boats
returned after a hard chase all day
hope to do better tomorrow mid and latter
part light winds from SE at 8 went in with
the boats saw humpbacks chased all day
do not get him

Saturday Aug 29
fine weather Boats in Chasing
Humpbacks at 6 returned
No whale yet mid and latter part
fine weather at 8 went in with the
boats Boats do ends

Sunday Aug 30th
fine weather wind from the SE
at 9 the Boats returned steamed
over for the island at 6 came too
with the main yard aback the
island bearing West 10 miles
mid and latter part fresh winds
from SE at 8 went in with the Boats
at Maridian returned No Whales

Monday Aug 31st
Commences fine weather cleared away
concluded to leave the island at 8
the long by Chooam 29° 18' at 8
in light sails exchanged signals with
an English Brig mid and latter part
winds and squally plenty of rain down

Tuesday Aug 31st 1858
Strong winds and squally rain at 6
Dubble Reefed furled the jubb and main
sail mid clear wind changed to the south
latter part light winds and heavy swell
Lat 21° 03'

Wednesday Sept 1st
light wind from the south at 6 calm
Several sail in sight during the day
mid and latter part fine weather wind
from the NW at 10 toward for a dudge
Bottom could not fasten
Lat 21° 10' Long 34° 43'

Thursday Sept 2^d
fresh winds from the NW heading to
the NW by the at 6 in main S.C. sail
mid and latter part strong winds from
the south squally down rain at 8
Dubble Reefed steamed away & do ends
Lat 21° 32' Long 36° - 50

Friday Sept 3^d
Strong winds from SE cloudy
steaming away & Dubble Reefed mid
and latter part fine weather steaming
away & cloudy do ends
Lat 21° 51' Long 38° 00'

Saturday Sept 4th
moderate cloudy weather steaming away & at
8 steamed SE mid and latter part moderate
winds from the SE steaming SW
Lat 23° 00' Long 39° 10'
