

Sunday Nov. 10th 1858
Calm employed stowing oil in
the main hatch at night subtle
breeze middle moderate breeze from
the East at 4 wind changed to the W. Rain
and squally at 8 commenced stowing
oil in the main hatch so ends

Monday Nov. 11th
Commenced with Rain squally at 6 finished
stowing checked off the main hatch at 8
8 1/2 fathoms. hove to head to the South
mid and later part moderate fine weather
at 4 hove to for Right Whale no hit him
at 11 hove to again saw several struck
and down the spar but the whale
left 35. 56 at 6 in the morning
4 1/2 fathoms

at night 4 1/2 "
did not go in shore more
than 8 mile should end
quick

Tuesday Nov. 12th
fine weather calm middle the
same later light airs at 9 saw whale
hove to chased several fathoms then
very close at 11 struck and the
spar broke. but the whale again
had luck left 36. 41 fathoms 38 to 42 fathoms
in the fore of the day
saw quite a number
of whales but very
few

Wednesday Nov. 13th 1858
fine weather light winds from the
North saw whale and chased but nothing
mid moderate later strong winds at
3 hove to and struck a whale at 12
took him to the ship so ends
left 36. 06 62 fathoms
saw 52 + 55

Thursday Nov. 14th
strong winds from the North
cutting fair at 10 hove to Rugged weather
at 1 1/2 finished got supper and set
the whale mid and later moderate
fine weather left 35. 56. 58 fathoms
saw whales

Friday Nov. 15th
calm employed Bailing at 4 thick
fog middle the same later Rain thunder
at 8 o'clock Bailing took a strong
breeze from the East
at 10 calm commenced stowing
down at oil in the fore hold
so ends left 36. 08. 40 fathoms

Saturday Nov. 16th
calm foggy at 9 began Bailing
mid strong later part light airs
and calm. stowing oil in the fore
hold so ends. Dressed on Bottom
took a light breeze from the
East steamed at 1 1/2
