weather at night double reefed head
to the NE. plenty of birds and fish
mid and latter part moderate breeze
heading to the NE by the wind
Lat 39° 53' Long 54° 03'

Tuesday Jan 25 1859
fine weather winds from the NW
heading to the NE by wind mid and
latter part strong winds at 9 took in
sail for the foresail by head to the
NE strong Gale from NW
Lat 39° 36' Long 53° 20'

Wednesday Jan 26th
Strong Gale from NW gradually
halling to the West at set the fore
sail at 10 reefed the main & sail
at double reefed fore & sail mid
NW steered NW mid and latter
part fine weather winds from NW
steering NW NW saw one Bark
Lat 38° 02' Long 52° 36'

Thursday Jan 27
Strong winds from the NW steering
NW at night in sail mid and latter
part strong winds from the South
steered to the North under short
sail
Lat 36° 04' Long 52° 11'

Friday Jan 28 1859
Strong winds from the South
at midnight hauled 60 fathoms
more ship steered E by S double
reefed at night in sail saw a sail to
the NW of us mid and latter part
moderate winds and heavy swell heading
to the NE at 11 more to the West
Lat 36° 11' Long 51° 46'

Saturday Jan 29 1859
light winds from South light
swell at night in sail mid and latter
part moderate winds southerly heavy
swell heading to the East at
midnight steered North
Lat 36° 04' Long 51° 20'

Sunday Jan 30
light winds from the South heavy
swell at 3 PM hauled the ship
dragged. Upland 48 days from Boston
for San Francisco and more ship in
sight head on the Eastern tack mid and
latter part moderate winds and high
swell at midnight squally rain &c
took in sail at 11 spoke the Evening

Lat 36° 04' Long 51° 20'

Monday Jan 31
Strong Gales from the NW bying
head to the Westward under
iron company mid and latter part
strong winds from NW bying to the
to the NE at 10 more to the West
He represented a southerly current
Lat 36° 19' Long 51° 36'
