

Monday March 28 1859  
Strong winds from the SW good  
weather leading to the NW by the  
wind mid and latter part moderate  
winds from SW to NW 40 fathoms  
Lat 40. 59 Long 56. 40

Tuesday March 29  
Fine weather calm and light airs  
mid and latter part light winds from  
the SE heading to the North by the  
wind Lat 40. 24 Long 58. 36  
60 fathoms

Wednesday March 30  
Fresh winds from the SE  
heading to the North by the wind  
at night in sail head to the North  
mid and latter part moderate variable  
at 4 took a squall from the West  
split the jib. Lat 39. 33 Long 58. 41  
60 fathoms

Thursday March 31  
Moderate and fine weather winds  
from SW by heavy light at 4 calm  
caught plenty of fish mid and  
latter part light airs and calm  
Lat 39. 04 Long 55. 31

Friday April 1st 1859  
Light winds from the North fine  
weather leading to the SE mid and  
latter part fine weather light winds  
from the North at Meridian saw a  
Breach, headed that way to End  
Lat 39. 01 Long 54. 16

Saturday April 2 1859  
at 1. saw the breach again at 1.5  
saw the ship up again. saw a person who  
it is toward the whaler named ~~Trinidad~~  
Chad caught being near ~~Canada~~  
board at dark in hopes of the main  
mid and latter part fine weather winds  
from the North saw nothing else  
this day Lat 38. 13 Long 53. 51

Sunday April 3 1859  
Fine weather light winds from the  
North heading to the West mid and  
latter part moderate winds from the  
North foggy all day

Monday April 4 1859  
Thick fog winds from the North  
at night in sail. cleared at 11  
and gave sail head to the East mid and  
latter part moderate winds from the  
North thick fog at 11 fog lifted made  
sail Lat 39. 02 Long 54. 34

Tuesday April 5 1859  
Light winds North some thick heading  
to the West by the wind at night in  
sail mid moderate at 2 AM wind changed to the  
North latter moderate cloudy at 10 headed  
to fathoms headed off to the SE squally

Wednesday April 6 1859  
Moderate winds from the SE heading to  
the SE rain 28 mid strong winds from  
the South latter strong gale  
Lat 38. 15 Long 54. 18
