Strong Gale from the South since

heading SW W. S. S.

Saturday June 8th
Strong winds from the NW heading
to the SW by the wind bubble reefed at
in fifth and fore sail mid and latter part
Strong Gale from the NW at 8 steered
South at Meridian came too head the West
Lat 40.49 Long 57.40 by S R

Sunday June 9th
Strong Gale from the NW by head to
the SW wind more moderate at 8
set the fore sails bubble reefed latter fresh
winds from the West at Meridian took
to the North Lat 41.15 Long 57.57

Monday June 10th
Fresh winds from the NW at 5 in
sail steered SE by E. mid and latter part
at 11 made sail steered NE at 11 toward for
a Right Whale. fresh breeze
Lat 40.55 Long 57.40

Tuesday June 11th
Strong winds both off at 4 took them
and in sail wind from the N. blowing
Strong lay head to the West mid and latter
part strong winds at 1 wind changed to
the South more to the West
Lat 40.34 Long 57.15
58 fathoms water

Wednesday June 12th 1859
Fine weather and strong winds from
the South increasing to moderate perhaps
for a while to morning mid and latter
fresh winds from the North heading
in West

Thursday June 13th
Strong winds from the North heading
to the West Clear reefed main sail
at 8 fore sail mid and latter part more
moderate heading to the West off
Lat 40.46 Long 58.50
46 fathoms

Friday June 14th
Fresh wind from the NW heading
to the SW by the wind at night in sail
steered SE by E mid and latter part moderate
Lat 41.13 Long 57.50
in the morning 67 fathoms steered SE 15 miles
63 fathoms steered East by S 15 miles 45 fms

Saturday June 15th
Moderate winds from the South
at night in sail head to the East
mid and latter moderate and foggy 22 fms

Sunday June 16th
Light wind and calm Caught a Mackerel
fish at 8 saw a large ship beyond
about the light air and calm weather
Lat 41.14 Long 56.14 by ship
57.16 by ship
in the morning 83 fathoms
head off to the West 10 miles
92 fathoms
