

Monday June 13. 1859
Calms with variable light winds from
different directions mid and latter
part moderate fine weather winds
from the East inclining to Breeze
Lat 40° 50' Long 58° 56' ship
58° the Capt

Tuesday June 14th
Fore part strong breeze from
the E at 3 saw three right whale
suble. Reeled and land did not
fasten found it heavy Breeze
saw the whales in Lat 40° 40'
middle and latter part strong
rain thunder Gales came 50 fathoms
and 50 fathoms

Wednesday June 15th
Fore moderate saw two whales to this
to hear middle fine weather latter
a strong breeze from the West at 8
saw two hauled for them could not
fasten came on Breeze took up the
boats got dinner 49 fathoms
Lat 40° 36' Long 57° 41'

Thursday June 16th
Strong winds from the West at 1
saw two for the same two whales
brought them off again at 4 saw
three more before we could get
to them came thick to late to do any
thing with them mid and latter
part moderate and fine weather
at 11 saw whales
Separated the lat to be 40° 10'

50 fathoms
Water
saw quite a lot of whales
say 10 or 12 but we have not

Friday June 17. 1859
moderate fine weather saw all the
after noon found the whales very wild
could not get any whale near them
mid and latter part moderate fine weather
caught lots of fish saw plenty of whales
very wild hauled several times could
not get fast Lat 40° 49' Long 57° 02'

Saturday June 18th
moderate winds from the North
lots of whales in sight came thick
fog at 12 at 2 fog lifted hauled and
caught a whale took him to the ship
at 5 commenced backing at 11 fished
found it slow work in the dark
latter part strong Gales from the
North head to the NE at 11 more to the
West No other

Sunday June 19th
Fore part strong Gales at 5 commenced
Railing a little more moderate wind
still to the North mid and latter part
strong Gales from the North
Lat 41° 24' Long 57° 41'

Monday June 20th
Strong Gales from the North head
to the West employed Railing mid and
latter part strong Gales from the North
headed to the West Railing
Lat 41° 43' Long 58° 21'

Tuesday June 21st
wind from the North at 2 more to the North
set the fore sail mid and latter part moderate
increased Railing at 10 AM at daylight steady sail
Lat 41° 43' Long 58° 21' in the
morning had to the NE 35 miles then 45 fathoms
