

Thursday June 30. 1859
fine weather light winds from
the south current setting the North
I hope the wind will change soon
mid and latter part moderate and fine
weather light airs from the North
steamed 11.20

Salt 39.59 Long 56.52

Friday July 1st 1859
fine weather winds from the North
steaming S.W. by S with the fore sail
set mid and strong winds at midnight
doubtless reached Cape Cod head to the West
head yards aback in the morning 5.2 AM
at 7 AM more ship steamed East 30
miles descended 48 fathoms kept going
East 10 miles more speed 44 fathoms
at 2 PM 57.14 at 5 PM 57.14 in 44 fathoms

Saturday July 2nd
strong winds from the North
at 5 in sail more head to the West
fore sail up mid and latter part strong
winds from the North descending in
52 fathoms steamed off East 30 miles
then had light 44 fathoms saw some
Humpbacks but no right whales hope
they have not left

Sunday July 3rd
strong winds from the North
heading to the East at night in sail
30 fathoms water mid strong wind latter
strong gales and thick lying head to the
West high sea

Monday July 4th 1859
strong gales from North rain
Thunder &c laying head to the West
mid strong winds and rain latter
moderate fine weather wind from
the S.W. steamed in different directions
to the Cross place where the whales was
seen last but they have gone and not
their name

Salt 41.04 50 fathoms water

Tuesday July 5th
fine weather wind from the W.S.W. at
night in sail lay head to the West 55 fathoms
mid moderate winds from the West at 3 calm
latter part fresh winds from the North
Salt 40.38 Long 56.56

Wednesday July 6th
strong winds from the North steaming
South in hopes to find the whales mid
and latter strong winds from the North
at 7 layed to head to the West sea nothing
Salt 42.14 off in the ships

Thursday July 7th
fresh winds from the N.W. at 8
more ship to the North at night in
sail heading S.W. mid and latter part
wind from the N.W. heading by the wind
to the North 40 fathoms

Friday July 8th
fresh winds from the N.W. heading by the
wind on the Northern track mid and latter part
moderate wind from West Salt 39.50 Long 56.14
54 fathoms in
