

Wednesday July 27. 1859
 Light winds and squally with rain.
 Steaming N by E at 2 heavy rain wind
 starts to the North headed off N by E
 middle strong wind and squally rain
 latter moderate wind more southerly
 heading N by E to N by W
 Lat 31° 06' Long 49° 20'

Thursday July 28th
 Fresh winds from the N by E heading
 N by W off employed washing the ship
 at 5 double reefed in spanker and
 gill mid and latter part fresh winds
 from the North at 11 more ship to
 the East at 5 more again to the N by E
 Green water thick fog thinking we
 were near the land here the fog
 over passed 10 fathoms more ship
 off shore run ten miles miles E by S
 passed 8 fathoms left Rotom
 Lat by account 30° 30' Long 50° 00'

Friday July 29th
 Light airs from the North heading
 to the East by the wind middle calm
 latter part light airs heading N by E
 wind N by E Lat 30° 29' Long 49° 43'
 anchored at 8 in the
 morning 56 fathoms

Saturday July 30th
 Calm fine weather employed cleaning
 base middle fresh winds from the N by E
 at 11 tacked to the N by E 55 fathoms water star
 wind at 6 in main 50 sail at 3 double
 reefed at 6 more to the North at 7 more to
 the N by E in all sail but main & sail & fore
 sail blowing head Lat 30° 37'

Sunday July 31st 1859
 Strong gale from the N by E heading on the
 Eastern back Green water extends off along shore
 more than one degree from the land as
 you draw in near the land the water is
 very light. Catcher mid and latter part
 strong gale from the N by E heading to
 the Eastern putting a large sea
 Lat 31° 24' Long 48° 29'

Monday August 1st 1859
 Strong gale from N by E heading to
 the East. Caught reefed main & sail & fore
 spanker and stay sail mid and latter part
 strong gale from the North still on
 the Eastern back
 Lat 31° 50' Long 47° 20'

Tuesday Aug 2nd
 Strong winds from the North at
 at 3 saw an English schooner passing
 N by E sail out mid and latter part
 strong winds from the North at mid
 night tacked to the West
 Lat 31° 48' Long 47° 00'

Wednesday Aug 3rd
 Strong winds from the North at
 made a sea tacked to the N by E at 8 more
 moderate wind started to the West
 heading up over it by the wind all sail
 set middle and latter part fine weather
 at 2 took a breeze from the N by E
 N by W
 Lat 30° 13' Long 47° 00'
