

Friday Aug 12th 1859
fine pleasant weather at imployed
in all parts of work mid and latter
part fine calm weather getting off
water &c

Saturday Aug 13th 1859
fine weather winds southerly
mid and latter part the same

Sunday Aug 14th 1859
fine weather calm at 4 strong wind
from SW generally same thunder
mid and latter part strong Gale
from South rain &c

Monday Aug 15th 1859
strong Gale from South attended
with rain mid the same latter part
fine pleasant with fresh wind southerly

Tuesday Aug 16th 1859
fine weather wind southerly nine
one half the crew on liberty mid and
latter part fine weather getting off
water &c

Wednesday Aug 17th
light winds South West fine
weather stowing away water mid
and latter part moderate some foggy

Thursday Aug 18th
fine weather same as before getting ready
for sea as fast as possible mid and
latter part rain same thunder
and lightning remarkable wind
So End

Friday Aug 19th 1859
at noon can wind to the South at 5 had
rain and strong Gale set to the South
anchors brace the yard each way
middle more moderate latter fine
weather

Saturday Aug 20th 1859
fine weather imployed taking
off oranges & bananas &c

at V. Pelack Monday morning
took the anchors above the fant with
a very light breeze some foggy

Tuesday Aug 20th 1859
stowed the anchors about the cable
wind from South standing out to the South
& Starboard at 2 wind light heavy swell
second we could not get by left bay off
went out to the South at the 1st and
middle calm latter a light breeze from
the Starboard SW lat 24.14. long 48.04.

Wednesday Aug 21st
fine weather wind from the South
steering S by W imployed firing the boats
for whaling painting the &c mid
and latter part fresh winds from
the South steering South.

Lat 29.27 long 48.16

Thursday Sept 1st 1859
moderate winds from South steering
S by W at 4 light airs and high swell
middle light winds from South latter
strong breezes steering SW
Lat 31.09 long 49.19
