moderate and ~~fine~~ fine weather
light winds from the West
Lat 34 " 13 Long 54 " 26

Tuesday Sept 13
light winds from the West & calm
at 4 light wind from the North
mid and latter part fine weather
and nothing to be seen
Lat 34 " 14 Long 54 " 25

Wednesday Sept 13th
fine weather winds North Easterly
the India in sight mid and latter
part strong winds from the North
foggy at 4 set the topsails double
reefed Lat 36 " 55 Long 54 " 10

Thursday Sept 14th
strong winds from the North
at 4 in sail head to the East foggy
middle calm Rain thunder &c
latter part wind SEW
set fore sail steamed N
Lat 36 " 54

Friday Sept 15th
strong winds from the SEW at
night came to head to the West and
in fore sail mid and latter part fine
weather heading to the NE
Lat 36 " 29 Long 53 " 54

Saturday Sept 16th
moderate winds from the South
heading to the NE in company
with the India mid and latter
part moderate winds from the South
very fine weather
Lat 35 " 42 Long 53 " 20 " 30 fathoms

Sunday Sept 17th
fine weather light winds from the
South at 3 saw two whales supposed
to be Right Whales at 5 the India
sent a boat on board the bark Brothers
Got Papers as late as July 2nd 1859
found oil rather low " mid and
latter part fine weather wind from
SEW in the morning 60 fathoms steamed
East at 9.30 fathoms steamed East by 11 at
meridian more ship steamed NW
Lat 35 " 36

Monday Sept 18th
fresh winds from SEW at 6 in
sail head to the SE 37 fathoms water
the India in sight both ships run
over all this ground no matter day
from 15 to 20 miles apart have seen
no whales during the day mid and
latter part fresh winds from SEW in
the morning 58 fathoms water steamed
to the NE until aft sounding
Lat 34 " 50
