

Friday Sept 30 1859.
Strong wind from the SW heading
to the NW by the wind bubble. Rain
at night in sail head to the SW saw
several Humpbacks during the day
middle fine weather latter part calm
saw Humpbacks 15 fathoms
Lat 34. 44 Long 52. 00

Saturday Oct 1st
fine weather light airs from the
West in company with the India
middle and latter part moderate.
fine calm weather in the morning
Lat 34. 44 headed to the SW at 4
then the day with a light
breeze at 6. 41 fathoms

Sunday Oct 2nd
fine weather all thren. These
twenty four hours but no whales
Lat 35. 03 45 fathoms

Monday Oct 3rd
light airs from the NW at night
in sail calm the India in company
mid and latter part fine weather
saw Hump Backs and more
could not fasten
Lat 35. 30 Long 53. 00

Tuesday Oct 4th
fine weather at night saw
a bark to seaward then to him
passed to be the Ohio of Capt. B. B. B.
R. month 140 sperm latter fine
weather saw Right whales 7th
Humpbacks saw Run Bad cut
one Lat 35. 59 Long 53. 15

Wednesday Oct 5th 1859
fine weather saw several Right Whales
and lots of Humpbacks mid and latter
part strong winds saw plenty of Hump
and four Right Whales the India and
Ohio in sight Lat 36. 14 80 fathoms

Thursday Oct 6th
Strong winds from NW at 3 landed
for the whale they went to mind more
at 4 saw about 6 or 7 Right Whales
took in sail made ship to the NW
sounded when these whales was in
sight about 80 fathoms dark water
thought the latitude to be 36. 25
mid and latter part strong winds from
the NW thick fog at times saw two
Right Whales toward to thick to do any
thing. No Alas in the morning
44 fathoms saw the whale in 88 fathoms
stood off shore at Marazion sounded
got no bottom more ship to the
NW thick fog at 5 in sail moderate
at 8 Calm. Friday Oct 7. 1859
you will see I put a little
a head of my mack mid and latter
part moderate variable fog and saw
Killer Lat 36. 30. 94 fathoms Long 53. 15

Saturday Oct 8th
fresh wind from NW at 4 in sail
strong wind at 5 in fore sail heavy
gale from the SW by head to the SW
mid and heavy gale from the SW at
8 am more moderate latter part quite
moderate heading SE by the wind
Lat 36. 12. " 84 fathoms water
