

Thursday Oct 9th 1859
Strong winds from the SW at
4 wind SE light and heavy swell
spoke the India at night. Came
over the same Greenland whaler
we saw whales but they have fled
same when steamed SW at came to
main yard aback head to the north
in the morning saw plenty Humpback
at 8 saw and far right whales came up
under the Boat Got called went off
saw the India strike and kill one
and he sunk she took the lines to
the ship in all sail and layed by him
Lat 36° 24' from 40 to 50 fathoms

Monday Oct 10th
fine weather winds easterly at 3 P
saw the Indians Boat strike another
whale he run to the windward and
we lost the Run of the Boat the
India still laying by the sunken
whale the Ohio to windward at 8
spoke the Ohio towing the Indians
Boat down to the ship their whale
had sunk latter part fresh winds
from the East at 8 AM struck a
whale Run and launched
very bad cut the line
Lat 36° 17' 40 fathoms Water

Tuesday Oct 11th
Strong winds from the SE saw
saw very Ruff could not get up
at 6 spoke the Emma C. Jones 14
Mouth 800 mid strong winds and fog
latter strong Gale thick fog so ended

Wednesday Oct 12th 1859
Strong Gale thick fog at 2 fog lifted
steamed to the East at 4 saw right whales
beyond and shaded in between mid and
latter part fine weather saw the most
whales from 40 to 50 fathoms saw 6 ship and
Barks all chasing whales
Lat 36° 16'

Thursday Oct 13th
fine and calm weather at 7 saw
far whale to windward of the ship at
8:30 PM struck one 4 miles from
the ship killed the whale at 8 began
towing entirely calm at 9 Got killed
to the ship made fast for the night
cut him in the morning still calm
Lat 36° 17' about 60 fathoms

Friday Oct 14th
light airs from the East began
bailing at 2 PM no whale in
sight to ship Emma C. Jones
Rochees and Ohio mid and latter
part calm and light airs saw the Ohio
Boat down after 9 Right Grace then
off saw plenty Humpback
Lat 35° 59' 40 fathoms

Saturday Oct 15th
light airs from the East saw thick
impaired bailing mid and latter part
moderate and calm saw fog at
8 finished bailing at 8 commenced steaming
Lat 36° 09' at 4 in the morning
36 fathoms water plenty Humpback
steamed SE Lat 36° 09'
