

Tuesday Nov 11 1859  
fresh winds from the S.W. fine  
weather at 5 finished staving down  
steaming N.W. & wind light  
from the N. to the S. & Reeged the  
caught two whales in the first set  
from 36.20 to 36.10. from 80.60 fathoms  
water

Wednesday Nov 12  
strong winds and heavy swell  
standing still between decks mid and  
latter part moderate winds from  
the South at 8 spoke the India  
Lat 35.41. Long 52. fathoms

Wednesday Nov 13  
moderate winds from South West  
10 Whales in sight saw the  
Roscius take a whale mid and latter  
part moderate and calm no whale  
in sight Lat 35.59. Long 52. fathoms

Thursday Nov 14  
at 1 took a breeze from the North  
steamed S.W. middle fresh breeze by  
thru the night head to the N. at  
6.48 fathoms headed off to the 90 fathoms  
tacked in to the N.W. spoke the Waverly  
6 m out 500 sperm got letters from  
her Lat 36.30

Wednesday Nov 15  
fresh winds from the South head  
to the N. at 6 more ship launched 47 fathoms  
saw no whales at daylight made 80 fathoms  
head S.W. wind N.W. nothing in sight at  
10 tubbs Reeged equally  
Lat 36.44 Long 53.50

Thursday Nov 16 1859  
fine weather at 1. out Reegs set all sail  
wind to the North heading in mist at night  
in sail 86 fathoms fresh wind taking speed  
in the S.W. some thunder several sail in  
light mid and latter part strong Gale  
from the North at mid night wind changed  
to S.W. strong Gale  
Lat 36.44. Long 53. fathoms water

Friday Nov 17  
Clear weather strong Gale from S.W. &  
laying head to the N.W. nothing in sight mid  
and latter part strong breeze from the  
S.W. at 8 set double reefed topsails lowered 50 fathoms  
head in N.W. at 8 saw Right whales  
laward chased got nothing  
Lat 35.51. Long 51 fathoms water

Saturday Nov 18  
Clear fine weather strong wind from  
the S.W. at 4 laward for Right whales  
got up to one and let him go again  
saw a bark and the India take  
whales mid and latter part moderate  
at 9 laward for a Right whale at mid night  
him at 10.4 took him to the ship  
got dinner began cutting  
Lat 35.55. Long 51 fathoms water

Sunday Nov 19  
light winds at 4 finished cutting  
at 6 went on board of the bark steaming  
60 days from New Bedford got papers  
and letters in playe sailing  
mid and latter part fine weather  
plenty of ships but the whales has closed  
Lat 35.41 from thirty to 60 fathoms
