

Thursday Nov 24 1859
fine weather at night in sail
looking same specially mid and
latter part thunder some rain
wind and calm 8 ships in sight
Salt 38.03.57 fathoms

Friday Nov 25
at 1 a light wind from the SE
foggy steamed at 2 1/2 at 6 in
sail 38 fathoms by head to the
SE middle light winds with fog
at 6 fog lighted 30 fathoms more to
to the East wind SSE
Salt 36.53.13 sail in sight all
whaleman fear whale
is seen

Saturday Nov 26
fine weather saw one bark cutting
and 4 sailing saw several ships
chasing but saw no whales all this day
mid and latter moderate some
foggy Salt 37.05.50 fathoms

Sunday Nov 27th
fine weather saw lots of Humphreys
saw the Ohio take a right whale
but saw none, and saw mid
and latter part thick specially thunder
lightning at 9 fog lighted took a breeze
from the south at 11 saw the Florida
take a whale saw several sail
Salt 38.00.50 fathoms

Monday Nov 28 1859
fine weather wind from south
Humphreys saw several sail at night in
sail 38 fathoms water steamed SE mid
and latter part light wind from the SE
some thick 1/4 ships in sight
in the morning 36 fathoms No Ches

Tuesday Nov 29
light winds from the SE steamed to the
south at night in sail 56 fathoms
no whales this day middle specially thunder
with much lightning latter part fine
weather with a breeze from the south
at 9 saw one for Humphreys kid and
saw one
Salt 36.56.55 fathoms

Wednesday Nov 30
fine weather light winds from the
south at 6 calm caught plenty of fish
6 ships in sight and 1 whale mid
and latter part moderate calm weather
No whales but plenty of ships
36.36.54 fathoms

Thursday Nov 1st Dec 1859
fine weather light winds from the
North 1/4 ships in sight some
Humphreys No right whales mid and
latter part moderate fine weather
wind North heading to the East at
midnight tacked to the NW
Salt 36.33.53 fathoms
