Thick fog and calm at 6 a.
light breeze from the south
Still thick mid and latter part calm
and thick fog saying fishing in
about 55 fathoms

Tuesday Dec 20
Thick fog light air from the NE
heading off to the SE mid and latter
part wind light from the north from
that to open thick fog all the time

Wednesday Dec 21
wind NW Steaming SW short sail
very thick this is the fourth day
with fog mid and latter part thick
and squally wind from the NW
have one bark
Lat 39.55 Long 55.46

Thursday Dec 22
light winds from the north Steaming
to the SW at 6 in sail looking slightly
saw thunder and lightning middle
strong Gale from the North rain
and thunder latter strong Gale inclining
to the west Lat 40.19 Long 55.36

Friday Dec 23
Strong Gales from NW heading
to the SW by the wind middle moderate
at daylight but the breeze
strong breeze from the NW
at 11 Double Reefed high swell
Lat 40.57 Long 55.40

Saturday Dec 24 1858
Strong Gales from the North heading
in to the West at 4 in sail. saw one bark
Steaming SWW Double Reefed middle
a strong Gale from the North at 3 in sail
at 8 shore moderate but Double Reefed SW
wind heading to the west
Lat 41.10 Long 56.03

Sunday Dec 25
Strong winds from the SW at night
in sail blowing quite a breeze
mid and latter part strong winds from
the West heading to the South by the wind
Lat 42.18 Long 56.20

Monday Dec 26
Strong winds from the West inclining
to the South at 5 more ship to the
NW quite moderate mid and latter
part fine weather at midnight calm
at 4 light breeze from the North
steamed NW
Lat 42.59 Long 57.16

Tuesday Dec 27
fine weather wind from the NW
Steaming NW mid and latter part
moderate winds from the North
Lat 43.10 Long 57.50

Wednesday Dec 28
fresh winds from the NW heading to
the SW by the wind it 1 more ship to the
North wind to the West mid and
latter part fine weather light
winds variable
Lat 42.28 Long 58.20
